<u>Funding Forms:</u> If your child is entitled to funding we will approach you in the coming week for you to complete and sign the relevant paperwork if you have not already done SO. Please note: children are entitled to funding from the term following their third birthday, up to the 30th of March for Summer term entitlement. If your child's birthday falls....April 1st to August 30th they are not eligible until September. We must have seen your child's birth certificate as this is a funding requirement.

New Committee members: As a registered charity, we are run by a committee of volunteer parents, without which we could **not function**. As children and parents move onto pastures new we are always looking for new members to join. If you wish to join us or have any questions about what is involved then please ask any member of staff. Play group Fees: Following a review of our finances and the pending increase of the minimum wage, rent etc, the decision was made by our Committee to increase our session costs to £13.50 from after this term.
